

Au Pair Visa

The Federal Employment Office informs on their homepage with regard to au pair stays and the rights and obligations of the host families and the au pair involved with these stays: https://www.arbeitsagentur.de/unternehmen/arbeitskraefte/au-pair

The requirements for the approval for an au pair stay are (Basic law: § 19c Abs. 1 AufenthG i.V.m. § 12 BeschV):

- You need be between 18 and 26 years of age at the time of application.
- You should to have <u>basic</u> German language skills; to be assessed on application interview
- The host family must communicate in German as first language
- You cannot apply as Au-Pair to relate family
- Residence permit for an Au-Pair is issued for one year only
- Duration of employment minimum of 6 months but no more than 12 months

Applications can be submitted in person, with prior appointment and the following application documents:

- Personally signed passport (original with one copy of the passport data page), with at least two
 completely empty pages and sufficient validity
- Valid Swiss residence permit with one copy
- Application form fully completed and signed including declaration to section 54 residence Act:
 application form with one copy
- One passport sized **photo** no older than three months, according to biometric standards
- Original signed **Au Pair** contract with one copy
- Copy of passport from the host parents
- Au Pair questionnaire with one copy
- o **Invitation letter** from the host family with one copy
- o German language skills level A1
- O Detailed curriculum vitae and motivation letter in German or English language with one copy
- o Au Pair health insurance for one year with a minimum coverage of 30.000 EUR with one copy
- Postage expenses of 7 Swiss Francs
- Visa fee of 75 Euro payable by cash in Swiss Francs, by Visa or MasterCard (information here)

The interview will be in German language to prove your german language skills (level A1).

Original documents will be return to you while a copy per set will be required. Missing documentation delays the procedure and can result in your application being rejected.

The German Embassy Bern reserve the right to ask for additional documents at any time during the processing of your application.

In this visa category, most applications are typically processed within 5 weeks. Please do not contact the mission abroad to check the status of your application during the normal processing period. Such inquiries are extremely time-consuming for the visa department and cannot be answered. We will contact you by email as soon as the decision has been made.

The visa will be valid for 6 month and allows you to start working as an Au Pair. You can travel in the entire Schengen area for 90 days per half year. You should apply for the extension of your visa at the competent migration office at your place of residence.
