

Visa for skilled workers holding a university degree

Last update: January 2024

As a skilled worker with an academic qualification recognised in Germany, you can be issued with a residence permit to engage in skilled employment that your qualification enables you to perform. You can find more about living and working in Germany at www.make-it-in-germany.com.

Applications can be submitted in person, with prior appointment and the following application documents:

- Personally signed passport (original with one copy of the passport data page), with at least two
 completely empty pages and sufficient validity
- Valid Swiss residence permit with one copy
- Application form fully completed: <u>application form</u> and signed information pursuant section 82 (1) residence act
- One passport sized **photo** no older than three months, according to biometric standards
- Employer's declaration ("declaration of employment") to be completed by your employer in Germany with one copy
- Work contract original with one copy and job description
- Original German university degree or recognized foreign university degree with one copy and printouts from <u>Anabin data base</u> - the qualification and academic institution need to be listed as equivalent or comparable and the university need to be rated with H+
 - Statement of comparability for foreign higher education qualifications, issued by the central office for foreign education (ZAB) in original with one copy
- o Detailed curriculum vitae in German or English language
- Postage expenses of 7 Swiss Francs
- Visa fee of 75 Euro payable by cash in Swiss Francs, by Visa or MasterCard (information <u>here</u>)

Please prepare the originals with **one set** of copies of all the indicated documents. Original documents will be return to you while a copy per set will be required. Missing documentation delays the procedure and can result in your application being rejected.

The German Embassy Bern reserve the right to ask for additional documents at any time during the processing of your application.

In this visa category, most applications are typically processed within 5 weeks. Please do not contact the mission abroad to check the status of your application during the normal processing period. Such inquiries are extremely time-consuming for the visa department and cannot be answered. We will contact you by email as soon as the decision has been made.

The visa will be valid for 12 month and allows you to start working. You can travel in the entire Schengen area for 90 days per half year.
